The Creation conference will offer 2 opportunities to pick from 4 breakout sessions. You are free to attend any one of them on that day, space permitting. In order to plan the room assignments, we are asking you to select your top choice for each session.

11:15 AM Breakout Session:

1) Meet Your Ancestors: Adam and Eve – presented by Dr. Rob Carter of Creation Ministries, International. Rob will present his latest analysis of worldwide DNA data which indicates we are all related and descendant from 2 humans - not that long ago. There is a lot of evidence not only for Adam and Eve, but also for Noah's Flood and the Tower of Babel. Where is this evidence? In our genes! Come and hear about the history of the world as we know it from genetics. This presentation will be on the level of senior high school and up.

2) Genetics, Natural Selection & the Death Throes of the Neo-Darwinian Synthesis - presented by Steve Grimes of Mo. Assn. for Creation. Steve will present an overview of discoveries in molecular microbiology and epigenetics that are game-changers for existing Darwinian evolutionary theory.

3) What about Human Evolution? – by Carl Kerby. Our children are often told that they are just glorified monkeys. This presentation investigates the evidence for ape to human evolution, including Neanderthals, Lucy and more. Once we look beyond the “veneer” at what the actual evidence really shows, you may be surprised! We need to know the real evidence that God has provided concerning these issues today.

4) Creation Evangelism: Foundational to the Gospel of Christ – presented by Scott Jarus of Mo. Assn. for Creation. 1 Corinthians 1:23 says: "but we preach Christ crucified, to Jews a stumbling block and to Gentiles foolishness". God has called us to go into all the world and proclaim the gospel. The foundation on which the gospel is built is found in the Book of Genesis. This presentation will show that an understanding of the origin of sin, its penalty and the need for a perfect sacrifice are the building blocks on which the Gospel can be proclaimed. Scott will share from the Book of Acts as well as from his personal conversion account.

2:15 Breakout Session:

1) Mt. St. Helens: Modern Evidence for the Worldwide Flood - In 1980 Mount St. Helens erupted and quickly became known as “God’s gift to Creationists.” Thirty years later geologist Dr. Steve Austin returned to the volcanic monument to discuss the catastrophic processes which reshaped the terrain and how they support the Biblical record of earth’s history. He presents his research on how the aftermath of Mount St. Helens matches geologic features such as the Grand Canyon and petrified forests at Yellowstone and obviously do not require millions of years to form.

2) Carbon-14 and the Age of the Earth – presented by Helmut Welke, MS, of Creation Summit. Helmut will review the history of old age beliefs and how the relatively recent development of carbon-14 dating contradicts those assumptions. Much of this C-14 information will surprise you.

3) Stephen Hawking: Theologian? – Presented by Marv Schaefer of Mo. Assn. for Creation. Prior to his death in March of 2018, Stephen Hawking was regarded by most as the premiere theoretical physicist in the world. He made many statements during his life about God and the “fact” that a creator was unnecessary. This presentation will look at what he professed and examine how well it holds up in the light of both scripture and natural law.

4) Arguments for Evolution: Weighed and Found Wanting – Presented by Steve Grimes of Mo. Assn. for Creation. This presentation will look at some of the arguments and put forth for evolution by the National Academy of Sciences and others. It will also look at the tactics they use and show the various logical fallacies they commit. Special attention will be given to the argument for molecules-to-man evolution based on homology or similarities between creatures.
